Our growing family is excited to get back on the road to present our burden for Portland, ME. November and December were extremely busy months for our family! We participated in a missions conference at four different churches in Florida, and I presented and preached in North Carolina, Virginia, Tennessee, New Jersey, Connecticut, and Massachusetts. We also enjoyed a short break to celebrate our 8th wedding anniversary, holidays with our family, and welcome our newborn son, Kaenan Michael, into the world. He was born on December 28, weighing 7lb 6oz, and is 19 inches long! Mom and Kaenan are both well, though we did have a short 48-hour return to the hospital as his bilirubin levels were very high. Thankfully, he has made a quick recovery, and his levels are in a safe range. I am thankful for the power of prayer and the many folks who interceded on his behalf.

The Lord brought to life Isaiah 55:11 in our hearts last month, which reads "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." I received a call from a man who found one of our Missions Passports (a small pamphlet we hand out to children with facts about Maine, our family, missions, and has a gospel presentation on the back) blowing in the wind while working security. He picked it up, read it, and accepted Christ as his personal Savior! It turns out that he found it over 20 miles from where we were presenting in Tennessee. The young man has been attending church and seems to be growing in his new walk with the Lord. God's Word is powerful! This testimony reminds me to hand out tracts everywhere I go; you never know where the gospel will end up.

I was also reminded (again) that God takes care of his people! While traveling in New Jersey our van began acting poorly and our camshaft broke down. With the upcoming cost of Kaenan's birth and travel expenses, we didn't have the money for the repairs, so I asked God's people to pray. Within 24 hours the bill was paid in full through the help of our home church, and the sacrificial giving of a gracious man, whom I've never met, that covered the remaining costs.

Our prayer requests are listed below, but one thing we are specifically praying for is that Evie (our six-year-old daughter) would have the opportunity to lead someone to the Lord. Each night during family devotions she prays that she personally sees someone accept Christ. We have been playing "the gospel game" with her, where her mother and I pretend to be a stranger, and she takes the conversation from introduction to conversion. We ask questions, seek clarity, and even challenge doctrine. She is becoming very comfortable at sharing her faith and we would love to see the fruit of her labor.

We are humbled to partner with several new churches and are thankful for the opportunity to be their representatives to Portland, Maine. Thank you for your faithful prayers!
